There must be at least 1 dues paid KoC member on each team. There must be at least 1 adult 18 years or older on each team. Teams with an ordained Catholic clergy member receive a 6" bonus to their team score.

Species Included and a Quick Overview of the Layout and Rules

Species- Kokanee Salmon, Largemouth bass, Rainbow Trout, Walleye, Yellow Perch.

Location- There are 17 waterbodies included in this contest. 2-3 waterbodies from each of the 7 Montana fisheries regions. The contest rules include a list of all of them, fish allowed to be caught and submitted from each lake, and access points.

Format- This is a catch, photo, release style tournament. Participants are free to fish whenever (pending specific local regulations) they like within the start and end dates and times. If a participant wants to submit a fish for measurement, they will take a picture of it being measured and submit that photograph for scoring. Review the contest rules packet for instructions on properly submitting fish for scoring. Fish not submitted within these guidelines will not count towards a participant's score.

Scoring- Lengths will be rounded to the nearest inch. The participant with the most submitted inches from their fish will win. Participants may submit as many fish as they wish, but only the 5 largest will be scored. Of the 5, a maximum of 3 can be walleye or rainbow trout. Those with walleye or rainbow trout may submit another species for their last 2 fish.

Big fish and Small fish Bonus Pots- Participants may choose to take part in these contests. A participant's biggest fish will count towards their final total. A participant's small fish may be submitted separate from and will not count towards their 5 largest fish. As mentioned above, the winner of these competitions will win 50% of the pot entry fee total.
