

Mental Health



Merry Christmas to all! It's been an exciting and fast paced year for the mental health Program. Since our program began a year ago:

- ★ We have served over 80 clients in 29 different communities across Montana, both in-person and through telehealth.
- * As of November 15th, we have held a total of 643 counseling sessions.
- ★ Our clients have ranged in age from 9 to 80 years old with the average age being 46.
- ★ We have seen clients for a wide range of issues, including anxiety, grief, depression, PTSD, trauma, and much more.

A Story of Growth and Acceptance

We were able to support a gentleman dealing with career, family, medical anxieties, and depression. Through increased connection and practicing mercy and forgiveness for old hurts, he was able to engage more fully in all areas of his life and move forward independently. Mental Health First Aid and Education
In 2024, CSSM hosted 3 sessions across
Montana that aimed to educate and empower
participants to help those experiencing a
mental health crisis. These sessions vary in
length and are offered to first responders,
teachers, church leaders, and anyone else
wanting to help their community. The
sessions will continue to be offered in 2025.
